Proposal for University of Miyazaki Short-Term ALI Program Spring 2017

Introduction

Indiana University of Pennsylvania (IUP) and the community of Indiana offer many advantages for students from the University of Miyazaki. We hope to have the opportunity to work with your students in a short-term spring semester program developed by the American Language Institute (ALI).

ALI is IUP's long-standing intensive English program. We offer students individual attention in small classes with experienced highly-qualified instructors. In addition to intensive English instruction in class, University of Miyazaki students would also benefit from interactions with peer tutors, service learning experiences, cultural excursions, and IUP clubs and organizations.

University of Miyazaki participants would have access to the resources of our university campus. They would stay in our modern comfortable on-campus housing (Wallwork Hall) and have meal plans for our on-campus dining halls. The university library, gym, indoor pool, local bus, and other facilities are all available to ALI students.

The Office of International Education (OIE) will organize transportation for the cohort from Pittsburgh International Airport to IUP as well as transportation back to the airport at the conclusion of the program. IUP is approximately a 2-hour drive from the Pittsburgh International Airport.

The OIE will arrange an excursion to introduce students to Pittsburgh, an attractive and culturally-rich metropolitan area about one hour from campus. Other options for cultural excursions include Washington, D.C., local attractions, and regional state parks. In addition to excursions, students will be able to participate in university and community events and programming.

IUP Background

Indiana University of Pennsylvania (IUP) is a medium sized public university that has been educating students in southwestern Pennsylvania since 1875. Indiana, a safe livable town which rests in the foothills of the beautiful Allegheny Mountains, offers a welcoming community. Students can experience nature in local parks as well as enjoy a vibrant downtown area near campus with specialty shops, restaurants, and historic buildings.

IUP is a residential campus, which establishes Indiana as a quintessential American university town. IUP is a member of the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education and is accredited by the Middle States Association Commission on Higher Education. With an enrollment of nearly 14,000, including 900 international students and scholars, IUP offers a wealth of academic resources and student services.

ALI Background

The American Language Institute at Indiana University of Pennsylvania has been welcoming students from around the world for more than 30 years. The ALI offers intensive English programs for students who want to improve their language proficiency and cultural understanding of the U.S.

We have worked with students from all over the world and have a long history of receiving exchange students from partner universities and creating specialized programs for groups. The ALI prides itself on academic excellence with highly qualified teachers, challenging courses and individual attention for our students. All ALI instructors possess, at a minimum, a relevant master's degree and teaching experience. Many ALI instructors are pursuing or currently hold doctoral degrees in English, Education, and Communication Media.

The ALI offers several program options to meet the language learning needs and academic interests of international students. An ALI certificate and IUP transcript will be provided at the end of the program. The ALI typically offers five levels of study with a variety of classes including reading, writing, speaking, listening, grammar, vocabulary, technology, and intensive tutoring with a peer mentor.

Additional Costs

Roundtrip flight to the U.S.

Students are responsible for arranging air transportation. Transportation from Pittsburgh International Airport can be arranged through the OIE.

Students are responsible for SEVIS and visa fees.

Course Materials and Textbooks

Students should budget \$50-100 for textbooks and other course materials.

Cultural excursions are optional. Costs typically range from \$5-60 to cover transportation and vendor fees. Destinations and dates may be changed based on student interest and availability.

Personal Expenses

The recommended amount for personal expenses is \$50 per week but this varies by individual.
