Attention all students:

Policies to Counter Spread of COVID-19 Following Declaration of Nationwide State of Emergency

On April 16 (Thur.) the Japanese government extended the state of emergency to include the entire country. This announcement is to inform students of the measures the University of Miyazaki is taking in response to the emergency declaration.

In order to help curb the spread of the virus, we ask every student to limit unnecessary trips outside the home and take every measure possible to avoid the risk of infection.

Individual facutlies and departments may implement additional measures in the future, so please follow whatever directions you receive. Please also note that the university may revise its measures further depending on the situation with regard to the state of emergency.

DETAILS

- 1. Regarding Classes
 - Classes will begin from May 11 (Mon.)
 - In some faculties/departments, "distance learning" (online) classes may begin earlier than that, so please follow whatever directions you receive from your faculty/department
 - For first-year undergraduates, the explanatory meeting to distribute the ID (email address) students use for communication regarding classes etc. will be held by some faculties on May 7 (Thur.) or May 8 (Fri.). Information regarding the meeting will be posted on the university website so please check it regularly to obtain the needed information.

- 2. Temporary Suspension of Student Services Section
 - Until May 6 (Wed.) the student services section and student services sections of each faculty will not be open
 - If you have an urgent matter that needs to be addressed, please contact student services via email (see Attachment)
- 3. Student Life Until May 10 (Sun.)
 - Some class-related work may be assigned for your classes, so please do whatever work is assigned to you
 - In principle, students should not enter the campus. However, a student may be allowed in a case where he or she receives permission from a faculty/department
 - · Avoid making unnecessary trips outside the home; be sure to wear a mask when

going out to purchase necessary items for your daily life, etc.

- Do not leave Miyazaki Prefecture to travel or return to your hometown
- In principle, students should not work a part-time
- Please follow the requests made in the April 13 annoucement regarding the health checklist, ban on extracurricular activities, parties, banquets, etc., and avoding the "3 C's" (closed spaces, crowded spaces, close-contact settings)
