Two-week Postponement of Spring Semester (2020)

Notice to all University of Miyazaki students and guardians:

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the University of Miyazaki will postpone the beginning of the spring semester from April 6 to April 22 (with some possible exceptions determined by each faculty).

During the two weeks prior to classes it is important that students remain in Miyazaki City to prepare for the start of the semester, rather than traveling elsewhere. We also ask that students act responsibly by monitoring their own health during this time, while also avoiding closed spaces with poor air circulation and gatherings of large numbers of people and also maintaining a distance from other individuals.

The university plans to begin the spring semester on Wednesday April 22, after confirming the situation with regard to the spread of COVID-19. There is a possibility that it will be necessary to further postpone the semester, so we ask for the understanding and cooperation of students and guardians in advance.
